Device description

Cath Tap is a tap like device, which can be connected to foley catheters, which can operate to control the flow of urine from the catheter to outside.

Intended Purpose & Duration

Intended to be used for intermittent drainage of foley catheter.

Contraindications

No known contraindications.

Warnings And Precautions

• Use on or before the expiration date.

- Do not use if package is opened or damaged. Do not use the product if there is suspect that the product is not sterile.
- Upon completion of intended purpose, dispose of the device and its components if any as per local regulatory guidelines for bio-hazardous medical waste or as informed by physician during training.

Instructions For Use

- 1. After inserting of foley catheter, connect the Cath Tap to the drainage port of the catheter.
- 2. And cath tap can be connected to urine bag also for collection of urine.
- 3. Turn the knob on the device to open position, when ever drainage from the catheter is required.
- 4. Turn the knob on the device to close position to stop the drainage from the catheter.

Intended population group

Adult male population who have temporary urinary incontinence.

Supply and Storage

The device is packed in medical grade pouch made of polyethylene and Tyvek. Supplied sterilized by Ethylene Oxide gas in peel open package. Device shall be stored at temperature range from 20°C to 40°C and away from direct sunlight.
